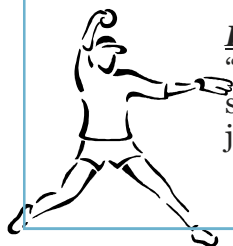

## CAN YOU HELP SUPPORT OUR NEWMAN CENTER

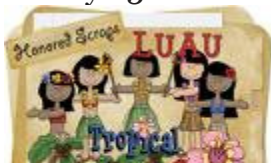
- Our annual expense budget is \$357,000 for the Fiscal Year 2010. These monies cover all our program and administrative expenses, salaries and benefits for both lay staff and our Dominican Friars, and the lease at Good Samaritan. Salaries and benefits are roughly 2/3 or the annual budget; expenses (including annual lease of \$70,000 plus utilities) 1/3 of the budget.
  - The Diocese of San Diego has generously contributed \$145,000 to our 2010 operating budget. Contributing members of our community: students, Young Adults, Resident community contributed \$159,000 in 2009. This year we will be using approximately \$50,000 of our Building Tomorrow Campaign funds. Through good stewardship we have been able to stretch our funds to meet previous budgets without tapping into this account.
